
*The Meaning of (La Ealha EIAllah)
(There is no GOD Except ALLAH the AI-Mighty)*

Note: In Islam ALLAH is used by the Muslims, whereas mostly other religions use God etc. Being a Muslim I am going to use ALLAH in this book and blogs.

This chapter is on the topic “The Meaning of (La Ealha EIAllah (There is no GOD Except ALLAH the AI-Mighty))”. Being a Muslim, my father only quoted from the Holy Book of QURAN and has tried to find out “The Meaning of (La Ealha EIAllah (There is no GOD Except ALLAH the AI-Mighty))”

About this Word ALLAH Almighty says in the Holy Quran:

“See you not how ALLAH sets forth a parable? A goodly Word like a goodly tree, whose root is firmly fixed, and its branches (reach) to the heavens, it brings forth its fruit at all times, by the leave of its Rabb² so ALLAH sets forth parables for men, in order that they may receive admonition.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (IBRAHIIM 24-25)

That is why, this WORD of ALLAH hold central place among all the true religions since Hadrat Adam till Hadrat Muhammad. This is the WORD which marks the boundary between rejection and faith. And according to ALLAH Almighty, it will remain eternal. Each period of human history produces such distinct persons who preserve its freshness and fertility so that the humanity gets the benefit of its fruit. The Prophet Noah was sent with the same WORD to preach to his people.

“And certainly, we sent Noah to his people; he said, “O my people Worship ALLAH! You have no other ‘ELAH’ but Him. Will you not fear (HIM)?”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Muminun-23)

In the subsequent periods after Noah, all the Prophets brought the same message to their people.

“Then We raised after him (Noah) another generation. And We sent to them a messenger from among themselves, (saying) “Worship ALLAH, you have no other ‘ELAH’ but (Him)?”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Muminun-31-32)

The Prophet Hadrat Hud was also sent with the same message.

“He (Hud) said, “O my people! Worship ALLAH! You have no other ‘ELAH’ but Him. You are only forgers.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Hud-50)

Hadrat Saleh also invited his people to the same (Kalima) WORD.

“He (Saleh) said, “O my people! Worship ALLAH; you have no other ‘ELAH’ but Him”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Hud-61)

The Prophet Shuaib’s message to this people was also the same.

“He (Shuaib’s) said, “O my people! Worship ALLAH; you have no other ‘ELAH’ but Him.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Hud-84)

The Prophet Moses received the first inspiration of Prophethood in the same WORD.

“(O Moses) verily, I am ALLAH; there is no ‘ELAH’ but I; so serve you me (only), and establish regular prayer for my remembrance.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Ta, Ha-17)

And when the community went astray and wished to surrender to some other power, Moses reproached them in these words.

“He (Moses) said, “Shall I seek for you an ‘ELAH’ other than ALLAH, when it is He Who has endowed you with gifts above the nations.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Araf-140)

The Prophet Yunus, when he was lying helpless in the stomach of the fish, prayed to ALLAH to forgive him for his access.

He (Zun-nun) cried through the depths of darkness, “There is no ‘ELAH’ but You; glory to You, I was indeed wrong!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Anbiyaa-87)

In order to prove the falsehood of the self-made creed of the Christians and refute their claim, ALLAH will ask the Prophet Christ on the Day of Judgment in the following words.

“ALLAH will say; “O Jesus the son the Mary! Did you say unto men, take me and my mother for two ‘ELAHS’ beside ALLAH?”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Maidah-116)

Essa (Jesus Christ) will nullify the self-created creed of Christianity i.e., Redemption, Trinity etc and thus refute his assigned partnership with ALLAH, Though Essa himself had never preached the doctrine of Trinity – the basis of polytheism existing in his name.

He (Jesus Christ) will say; “Glory to You! Never could I say what I had no right (to say). Had I said such a thing, You would indeed know it.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Maidah-116)

And the Holy Prophet Muhammad was made to enunciate the Word that there is none to serve except ALLAH.

Say; “ALLAH sufficiency me; there is no ‘ELAH’ but He on Him is my trust, He the ‘Rabb’ of the Throne Supreme.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Tanba-129)

Say; "He is my 'Rabb'! There is no 'ELAH' but He! On him is my trust, and to Him do I turn!"

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Rad-30)

Say; "Truly am I a Warner; no 'ELAH' is there but ALLAH."

Verses From the Holy Quran (Sad-65)

Say you; "I am but a man like you; it is revealed to me by inspiration, that your 'ELAH' is One 'ELAH'"

Verses From the Holy Quran (Ha-Mim as-Sajda-6)

ALLAH Almighty Himself wants to make mankind understand this fact, with great emphasis.

"Know therefore, that there is no 'ELAH' but ALLAH"

Verses From the Holy Quran (Muhammad-19)

"ALLAH! There is no 'ELAH' but He, the living, and the self-subsisting."

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Baqarah-255)

"And your 'ELAH' is one 'ELAH'; there is no 'ELAH' but He, The Rehman, The Rahim"

Verses From the Holy Quran (AL-Bqarah-163)

"ALLAH! There is no 'ELAH' but He, the living, the self-subsisting."

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Imran-2)

"ALLAH! There is no 'ELAH' but He of a surety He will gather you together no the Day of Judgment, about which there is no doubt. And whose word can be truer than ALLAH's?"

Verses From the Holy Quran (An-Nisa-87)

"Wonderful Originator of the heavens and the earth. How can He have

a son when He has no consort? He created all things, and He has full knowledge of all things.

That is ALLAH, your 'Rabb!' there is no 'ELAH' but He, the Creator of all things; then serve you Him; and he has power to dispose of all affairs."

(Al-An'am-101-102)

"Say; "O men! I am sent unto you all, as the Messenger of ALLAH, to whom belongs the dominion of the heavens and the earth; there is no 'ELAH' but He; it is He that gives both life and death. So believe in ALLAH and His Messenger. The unlettered Prophet, who believes in ALLAH and His Words; follow him that (so) you may be guided,"

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Naml-58)

From ALLAH, verily nothing is hidden on earth or in the heavens.

"He it is who shapes you in the wombs as He Please. There is no 'ELAH' but He. The Exalted in Might, the Wise."

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Imran-5-6)

"Or they may say, "He forged it. "Say (if a human being has the power to produce such a statement)" Bring you then ten suras forged, like unto it, and call (to your aid) whomsoever you can, other than ALLAH!" If you speak the truth!

"If then they do not honor your (call), know you that this (Book) is sent down (replete) with the knowledge of ALLAH, and that there is no 'ELAH' but He! Will you even then submit (to Islam i.e. to become Muslim)?"

Verses From the Holy Quran (Hud-13, 14)

"Ta-Ha. We have not sent down the Qur'an to you to be (an occasion) for your distress. But only as an admonition to those who fear (ALLAH).A revelation from Him Who created the earth and the heavens on high. The Most Gracious is firmly established on the throne.

To Him belongs what is in the heavens and on earth, and all between them, and all beneath the soil.

If you pronounce the word aloud, (it is no matter); for verily He knows what is secret and what is yet more hidden.

ALLAH! There is no 'ELAH' but He! To Him belong the Most Beautiful names (Attributes).”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Ta, Ha-1-8)

“Follow what you are taught by inspiration from your 'Rabb'; there is no 'ELAH' but He; and turn aside from polytheists.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-A'nam-106)

“Verily, I am ALLAH; there is no 'ELAH' but I; so serve you Me (only)”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Ta, Ha-14)

“ALLAH is He, than whom there is no other 'ELAH', who knows (all things) both secret and open, He, the Rehman, The Rahim.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Hashr-22)

“There is no 'ELAH' except ALLAH, and ALLAH-He is indeed the Exalted in Power, the wise.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-i-Imran-62)

In short ALLAH Himself is witness to this fact. His Angels are witness and all the learned men of judgment are witness to the fact that there is none to be served (worshipped) except ALLAH.

“There is no 'ELAH' but He; that is the witness of ALLAH; His Angels, standing firm on justice. There is no 'ELAH' but He the Exalted in power, the Wise.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-i-Imran-18)

The distinguished Messenger and last of the Prophet Hadrat Muhammad remained firmly witness to the fact that there is no 'ELAH' to be served (worshipped) except ALLAH.

“Can you possibly bear witness that besides ALLAH there are other ‘ELAH’? Say; “But in truth He is the one ‘ELAH’. And I truly am innocent of (your blasphemy of) joining others with Him.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-A’nam-19)

The companions of Kahf⁴ who received the credit of being faithful and guided ones from ALLAH won this high credit by virtue of their affirmation that there is only ‘ELAH’ to be served (worshiped).

“We gave strength to their hearts; they stood up and said; “Our ‘Rabb’ is the ‘ELAH’ of the heavens and of the earth; never shall we call upon any ‘ELAH’ other than Him, if we did, we should indeed have uttered an enormity.”

“These our people have taken for worship ‘ELAH’ other than Him; why do they not bring forward an authority clear (and convincing) for what they do? Who do more wrong than such as invent a falsehood against ALLAH?”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Kahf-14-15)

The purpose of the lifelong struggle of the true servants of ALLAH is to keep firm to this Word (Kalima) themselves and to invite others to follow the path of ALLAH. They try their best to divert the attention of those immersed in worldly affairs to the glory of ALLAH. Because they know that the welfare of this world and the world hereafter lies in this Word (Kalima). That is why that those pious servants emphasized upon their kindred to keep firm to this Word (Kalima) at the moment of their departure from this world. And if anyone of their relatives is on the verge of death, they stress upon him to keep firm to this Word (Kalima). It was the same conviction which forced the Prophet Muhammad to ask insistently his kind uncle Abu Talib to affirm his belief in the same Word (Kalima) while he was at the point of death. It was the same affirmation which the Prophet Hadrat Yaqub took at that time from his sons when he was departing from them.

“Were you witnesses when death appeared before Yaqub (Jacob)?

Behold, he said to his sons, “What will you serve (worship) after me?”
They said, “We shall serve (worship) your ‘ELAH’ and the ‘ELAH’ of
your fathers, of Abraham, Ismail, and Isaac, the one ‘ELAH’ to Him do
we submit.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Baqareh-133)

(Note: Generally ‘Nahnu Lahoo Muslimoon’ is translated “we are obedient to Him”. It is perhaps rendered so, in order to make the meaning easy and simple. But in fact, its translation becomes so, “That we have recognized His Supremacy and surrendered before Him. We resigned ourselves to Him”).

The servants of ALLAH testify to the above mentioned facts. Those who believe in the contrary of it can produce no valid argument in the support of their statements. The Holy Qur’an asserts.

“If anyone invokes beside ALLAH, any other ‘ELAH’, he has no
authority thereof; (i.e. they cannot produce a valid proof or argument
in the support of their statement).”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al Muminum-177)

If they had any argument, they would have certainly advanced it, because they had been invited to do so.

“Have they for worship (others) ‘ELAH’ besides Him? Say, “Bring your
convincing proof.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Anbiyaa-24)

It is for this reason that when such claimants come to know the truth then they have no alternatives but to surrender. In this connection take the example of Pharaoh who proclaimed himself as ‘ELAH’ (God).

“Pharaoh said, “O chiefs! No ‘ELAH’ (God) do I know for you but
myself.” (i.e., as for my knowledge is concerned, I see no other ‘ELAH’
than me.)”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Qasas-38)

And he was denying the invitation of Moses and looked upon him as liar.

“Pharaoh said, “O Haman! Build me a lofty palace, that I may attain the ways and means-” “The ways and means of (reaching) the heavens, and that I may look up to the ‘ELAH’ of Moses; but surely, I thing (Moses) a liar!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Mumin-36-37)

He (Pharaoh) tried his best to compel Moses to give up his belief in ALLAH as ‘ELAH’ and declare him (Pharaoh) as the only ‘ELAH’ (god) instead.

“(Pharaoh) said; “If you take any ‘ELAH’ (god) other than me, I will certainly put you in prison.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Ash-Shu’araa-29)

But when he saw the impending death, he realized that the true being to be worshipped is someone else. The one to whom Moses invited and whom the Israel believed in.

“At length, when (Pharaoh) overwhelmed with the flood, he said, “I believe that there is no ‘ELAH’ (god) except Him whom the children of Israel believe in. I am of those who submit (to ALLAH is Islam.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Yunus-90)

ALLAH Almighty repeatedly makes us understand in the Holy Qur’an that there is no ‘ELAH’ except Him. He exhorts that if man uses his insight, he will be convinced that there is only One Being, One Power, One Will and One Ruler in the universe and that is Almighty ALLAH. Had it not been so, there would not have been a uniform system in the universe.

“If there were, in the heavens and the earth, other ‘ELAH’ (gods) besides ALLAH, there would have been ruin in both! (The heavens and the earth). But glory to ALLAH, the ‘Rabb’ of the Throne; (High is He)

above what they attribute to Him!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Anbiyaa-22)

“No son did ALLAH beget, nor is there any ‘ELAH’ (God) along with Him; (if there were many gods), behold each ‘ELAH’ (God) would have taken away what he had created and some would have lorded it over others! Glory to ALLAH! (He is free) from the (sort of) things they attribute to Him!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Muminun-91)

It is beyond doubt that anyone who worships anything else except ALLAH and seek sharer in ALLAH’s authority is a polytheist. ALLAH never forgives polytheism. He may forgive even a capital sin, but never forgives idolatry, because he has always enjoined that.

ALLAH forgives not (the sin of) joining other gods with Him, but He forgives whom He please other sins than this one who joins other gods with ALLAH, has strayed far, far away (from the right).”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Nisa-116)

Since any belief other than the Word (Kalima) leads to idolatry, because it brings a sharer in the authority of ALLAH and sharing ALLAH’s authority with anyone else is committing a capital sin, because he calls into question the oneness of ALLAH. It is a deviation from the path of guidance. That is why ALLAH has repeatedly enjoined not to call anyone else as a sharer in authority with Him.

“And make not another object of worship with ALLAH. I am from Him a Warner to you, clear and open.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Az-Zariyat-51)

“Take not with ALLAH another ‘ELAH’, or you (O man!) will sit in disgrace and destitution.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Bani-Israel-22)

“There are among the (precept of) wisdom, which your ‘Rabb’ has revealed to you. Take not, with ALLAH, another object of worship, lest you should be thrown into Hell, blameworthy and rejected.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Bani-Israel-39)

“So call not on any other ‘ELAH’ with ALLAH, or you will be among those who will be punished.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Ash-Shu’araa-213)

“(The sentence will be) “Throw, both of you, into Hell every contumacious rejecter (of ALLAH):”

“Who forbade what was good, transgressed all bounds, cast doubts and suspicions.”

‘Who set up another ‘ELAH’ beside ALLAH, throw him into a severe chastisement.’ “

Verses From the Holy Quran (Qaf-24-26)

Whenever, a false belief was introduced besides “Kalima” the Word of ALLAH. ALLAH sent Prophets for the reformation and guidance of His servants. He descended His Books and appointed Prophets for their guidance. Among these false beliefs is a belief in two permanent ‘ELAH’ (Gods) at work in the universe. One is of good and the other of evil. Similarly, one is of light and the other of darkness, one “Hirmun” and the other “Yazdan” ALLAH has condemned this belief in the following words.

“ALLAH has said, “Take not for worship two gods, for He is just one ‘ELAH’. Then fear Me (and Me alone).”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Nuhl-51)

And this injunction was applicable to all those who held faith in the Sacred Books of ALLAH to have faith in the “Kalima” (There is no ‘ELAH’ except ALLAH).

“Nor did the people of the Book make schisms, until after there came to them clear Evidence. And they have been commanded no more than this; to serve (worship) ALLAH, offering Him sincere devotion, being

true (in faith).”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Baiyina-4-5)

But despite that they followed illogical, strange and absurd doctrines. Some of them declared Jesus Christ (Essa) the son of ALLAH, while others believed in the Prophet Uzair as the son of ALLAH. Some acknowledged three ‘ELAH’ (Gods), while others believed in the Trinity- the union in one godhead of three persons; Father; Son and the Holy Ghost. Some made the mythical deities as the partners of ALLAH, while others believed in the prophets, mystics and scholars as their saviors. Some maintained that the Angels are the daughters of ALLAH, while other invented relationships between the Jinn (Spirit) and ALLAH, ALLAH Almighty rejected all these hypothetical assumption through His Book and called mankind in general and the followers of the Holy Books in particular to come to the central point which is ‘LA ILAHA ILLALH’ (Verily, there is no ‘ELAH’ except ALLAH). For example, the translation of some verses from the Holy Qur’an is quoted here.

“O people of the Book! Commit no excesses in your religion; nor say of ALLAH aught but the truth. Jesus Christ, the son of Mary was (no more than) a Messenger of ALLAH, and His Word, which He bestowed on Mary, and a spirit proceeding from Him; so believe in ALLAH and His Messengers. Say not “Three:” desist: it will be better for you: for ALLAH is One ‘ELAH’ glory be to Him: (For Exalted is He) above having a son. To Him belong all things in the heavens and on earth. And enough is ALLAH as a Disposer of affairs.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (An-Nisa-171)

“If they desist not from their word (of blasphemy), verily a grievous chastisement will befall the disbelievers among them.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (An-Maidah-73)

“They take their priests and their anchorites to be their ‘Rabb’ (Lords) beside Christ the son of Mary; yet they were commanded to worship but one ‘ELAH’. There is no ‘ELAH’ but He. Praise and glory to Him; (far is He) from having the partners they associate (with Him).”

Verses From the Holy Quran (At-Tauba-31)

“It is not (possible) that a man, to whom is given the Book, and wisdom, and the prophetic office, should say to people; “Be you my worshippers rather than ALLAH’s on the contrary (he would say); Be you worshippers of Him (Who is truly the Cherisher of all); for you have taught the Book and you have studied it earnestly.”

Nor would be instructing you to take angels and Prophets for Rabb and patrons. What! Would he bit you to unbelief after you have bowed your will (to ALLAH in Islam)?”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Imran-79-80)

“And they have invested a kinship between Him and the Jinns; but the Jinns know (Quite well) that they will be brought before Him.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Saffat-158)

“Yet they attribute to some of His servants a share with Him truly is man clearly unthankful.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Az-Zukhruf-15)

“And they make into females Angels who themselves serve (worship) ALLAH. Did they witness their creation? Their evidence will be recorded, and they will be called to account!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Az-Zukhruf-19)

“And they assign daughters for ALLAH-Glory be to Him! - and for themselves what they desire! (i.e., sons)”

Verses From the Holy Quran (An-Nuhl-57)

“And they say, “The Rehman has taken a son” Glory to Him! They are (but) servants, raised to honor. They speak not before He speaks, and they act (in all things) by His command.

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Anbiyaa-26-27)

“He to whom belongs the dominion of the heavens and the earth; no son has He begotten, nor has He a partner in His dominion; it is He

who created all things, and ordered them in due proportions.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Furqan-21)

“They say, “ALLAH has begotten a son! His are all things in the heavens and on earth! No warrants have you for this! Say you about ALLAH what you know not? Say, “Those who forge a lie against ALLAH will never prosper.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Yunus-68-69)

“And to warn those who say, ALLAH has chosen a son. No knowledge have they of such a thing, nor has their fathers. It is a grievous thing that issues from their mouths as a saying. What they say is nothing but falsehood!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Kahf-4-5)

“They say; “The Rehman has betaken a son!”
Indeed you have put forth a thing most monstrous!
At it the skies are about to burst, the earth to split asunder, and the mountains to fall-down in their ruin. That they attributed a son to the Rehman.
For it is not consonant with the majesty of the Rehman that He should beget a son.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Maryam-88-93)

It is a slavery of the desires to fulfill every wish. It is like making ‘ELAH’ of your wishes.

“Have you seen him who makes his desire his ‘ELAH’ and ALLAH sends him astray purposely, and sealed his hearing and his heart and put a cover on his sight. Then who will guide him after ALLAH (has withdrawn guidance)? Will you not then heed?”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Jathiya-23)

It is strange to note that whoever raised the voice of the “Kalima” he was dubbed as insane, poet and given many other disgraceful titles.

“For when it was said unto him; there is no ‘ELAH’ save ALLAH, they were scornful. And said; shall we forsake our ‘ELAH’ (Gods) for a mad poet? Nay, but he brought the Truth and he confirmed those sent (before him).”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Saffat-35-37)

“So they wonder that a Warner has come to them from among themselves! And the unbelievers say, “This is a sorcerer telling lies! “Has he made gods (all) into one ‘ELAH’? Truly this is a strange thing!” And the leaders among them go away (impatiently), (saying), “Walk you away, and remain constant to your gods! For this is truly a thing designed (against you)! “We never heard (the like) of this in the last religion this is nothing but a made-up tale!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Sad-47)

When Noah told his people to take ALLAH as One ‘ELAH’ they replied;

“They said, “Shall we believe in you when it is the meanest that follow you?”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Ash-Shu’araa-111)

“The leaders of his people said, “Ah! We see you in evident error!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-A’raf-60)

“They said, “If you desist not O Noah! You shall be stoned (to death)”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Ash-Shu’araa-116)

When after Noah Hadrat Hud invited his people “A ‘ad” to believe in ALLAH as one ‘ELAH’ he was told,

“They said, “It is the same to us whether you admonish us or be not (our) admonishers!” (You are not alone who say so). This is not other than a customary device of the ancients. “And we are not the ones to receive pains and chastisement!”

Verses From the Holy Quran Ash-Shu’araa-136-138)

“They said, “Come you to us that we may worship ALLAH alone, and give up that which our fathers used to worship bring us what you threaten us with, if so be that you tell the truth!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-A'raf-70)

And further added:

“Ah! We see you are in folly and we think you are a liar.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-A'raf-66)

After the Prophet Hud, the Prophet Saleh asked his people ‘Samood’ to believe in the word of Truth, but his people responded to his call that:

“They said, “You are only one of those bewitched! You are no more than a mortal like us: then bring us a sign, if you tell the truth!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-Shu'araa-153-154)

When the well-off section of the tribe of the Prophet Saleh asked the poor, whether they had really affirmed the Prophet Saleh as the Messenger of ALLAH, they said in reply that they undoubtedly believe in his Prophethood from the core of their hearts. But the proud people said:

“The arrogant party said, “For our part, we reject what you believe in.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-A'raf-76)

When after Saleh Hadrat Lut asked his people to believe in one ALLAH as ELAH), to fear Him only, do good deeds and try their best not to commit sin, they (his people) replied:

“They said, “If you desist not, O Lut! You will assuredly be cast out!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Ash-Shu'araa-167)

Not only that the proud people threatened him, but also asked those under their influences to:

“And his people gave no answer but this: they said, “Drive them out of your city; these are indeed men who want to be clean and pure!”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-A'raf-82)

And when after the Prophet Lut the Prophet Shuaib persuaded the people of Madain to accept the truth, they replied that:

They said, “You are only one of those bewitched! You are no more than a mortal like us, and indeed we think you are a liar!” “Now cause a piece of the sky to fall on us, if you are truthful.”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Ash-Shu'araa-185-187)

His people threatened that they would exile him. The well off and proud people of his tribe told him to come back to their tribe; otherwise, he and his people would be turned out of the city.

“The leaders, the arrogant party among his people, said: “O Shu'aib! We shall certainly drive you out of our city- (You) and those who believe with you, or else you (you and they) shall have to return to our religion.” He said: What! Even though we do detest (them)?”

Verses From the Holy Quran (Al-A'raf-88)

And prevented the people under their influence from following him:

The leaders, the unbelievers among his people, said: “If you follow Shuaib, be sure then you are ruined!”

In short, the true religion turns on the point that,

“There is no 'ELAH' except ALLAH.”

(There is no GOD Except ALLAH the Al-Mighty)
